- 4. Candidate has completed similar projects and possesses the necessary skills and experience to successfully undertake this project.
- 5. The price is appropriate for the value being offered by the proposer.
- 6. The candidate vendor has an appropriate number of staff and the necessary expertise to develop the site promptly and efficiently.
- 7. The proposal is presented in a clear, logical manner, is well organized, and has the appropriate information which the RFP requests.
- 8. The proposal is clearly written, logically structured, well-organized and includes all the necessary information and pricing requested in the RFP.

Please note that project commencement is subject to confirmation of available funding. It may be necessary to delay or phase portions of the project to align with subsequent grant applications.
